INHOUSE POST SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS & APPLICATION

The eligibility requirements for the **2025 Craig Sarrasin Memorial academic scholarship** are as follows:

- Any applicant must be a graduating high school senior and an immediate family member of an AMVET, or subordinate Post 35 organization member. Immediate family member is defined as spouse, parent, grandparent, child and grandchild, brother and sister, any type of family-in-law. Any adopted or step children of an AMVET or subordinate organization of Post 35 members are included.
- The winning applicant must be enrolled in or accepted for enrollment to an accredited college, university, technical or other undergraduate school.
- The applicant must submit a 750 to a maximum 1,500-word essay discussing this year's topic, **"What can I do to be a good American?"**
- The essay, along with the below application, must be mailed or hand delivered to the Post and marked to the attention of the Scholarship Committee. **To receive consideration for this year's scholarship, all essays plus applications regardless of how transported, "must in the hands of a post official" no later than May 2, 2025. Any scholarship package received after midnight May 2, 2025 will not be included for consideration of this year's scholarship award.**
- The winning recipient must submit a copy of an acceptance letter from the college/university of their choice to the commander or finance officer prior to dispersal of any funds.
- Funds will be dispersed directly to the college/university on behalf of the recipient.
- Judging to take place no later than May 9, 2025. Winner announced will be on May 12, 2025.
